Form of citation

Memoirs of Alberto Marino entitled "The Sudan", giving an account of his experiences in the Sudan from 1934 to 1955. Includes notes on statistics and geography of the Sudan (SAD.721/3/7-8); account of his journey from Egypt to the Sudan in 1934 (SAD.721/3/10-27); account of the life of Romolo Gessi and his role in the elimination of the slave trade (SAD.721/3/31-38); description of Jabal Auliya dam site in 1934 (SAD.721/3/39-44); account of his work at Malakal in Upper Nile Province (SAD.721/3/48-67); transfer to El Fasher in Darfur to supervise the construction of a large artificial water basin (SAD.721/3/82-88); the outbreak of war, 1937 and repercussions on the Sudan (SAD.721/3/90-106); account of Marino's life as an internee (SAD.721/3/107-144); life in El Geneina, Darfur (SAD.721/3/145-154); work on the construction of Kassala bridge over the Gash River, 1948, the Wadi Golo reservoir, El Fasher and the El Ein reservoir, El Obeid (SAD.721/3/160-176); account of missionary work among the Dinka (SAD.721/3/179-183); the mutiny in Wau, Equatoria Province, 1955 (SAD.721/3/193-200); description of Independence Day, 1956 (SAD.721/3/207-211); and the first Sudanese election (SAD.721/3/239-244)
