Form of citation

Most printed references take the form: SAD. reference number.

To order items in the searchroom, use the collection reference code(s), derived by removing the repository code (GB-0033-), followed by the reference number. Citing the section of the finding aid is useful.

Mahdist banner, with Arabic inscription:

"O God, O Merciful One, O Compassionate One O Living One,

O Subsisting One, O Lord of Majesty and Honour

There is no god but God. Muhammad is his messenger

Muhammad al-Mahdi is the Successor to the messenger of God".

White text on black background, within white borders.

SAD.G//S 1543/2 [late 19th century]

Ethiopian shield. Domed metal base, leather handle and covering; decorated on the face with 20 metal plaques radiating round the center, and with 6 square and 4 round plaques at the centre, all attached to the base with pins
