UC/P3/1 11 June 1907 - 2 September 1910

Robert Hugh Benson to Edwin Bonney, mostly concerning Benson's *The cost of a crown: a story of Douay & Durham, a sacred drama in three acts* (London, 1910), with one letter (23 February n.y.) concerning his pursuit of a "fraud" named "Primmer", the nephew of the anti-Catholic lecturer, Jacob Primmer.

Joseph Gillow, mostly to Bonney with one letter to Joseph Corbishley, mainly about research into John Lingard in connection with Hallé and Bonney's book *Life and Letters of John Lingard, 1771-1851* (Herbert & Daniel, 1911).

M[?arie] Hallé, mostly to Bonney, with two letters from Herbert & Daniel (publishers), and one letter from William Brown mainly about Hallé and Bonney's book *Life and Letters of John Lingard, 1771-1851*.
